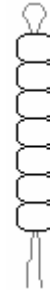


Begin by cutting your lacing to appropriate sized strands. Fold in half with ends even.

Starting at the top of row 1 of the pattern, string the beads onto the lacing working from the top down. Leave 1/4" of lacing showing at the bottom.

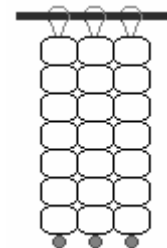


Tie a square knot in the lacing ends and pull tight to make the knot secure.

Holding both ends, carefully pull the knot back up into the last bead. Trim the ends.



Holding both ends, slip the loop over your straw, rod, or hanger. Continue working rows and adding them to your project.



When you have all of your strands done, use ribbon, cording, or material of your choice for the hanger.
